

EPA National Water Reuse Action Plan to highlight REUSExplorer tool

September 19, 2022 at 5:00 AM

EPA's National Water Reuse Action Plan will hold a free webinar on September 21 from 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. ET to cover REUSExplorer, a web-based tool that shows state water reuse regulations and guidelines. REUSExplorer (<https://www.epa.gov/waterreuse/regulations-and-end-use-specifications-explorer-reuseexplorer>) also highlights the underlying technical basis of water quality metrics and treatment requirements for each regulation.

The tool and webinar are meant for stakeholders interested in developing laws or policies for reuse, understanding the technical aspects of a regulation or guideline, and identifying any regulations on reuse applications within a state.

The National Water Reuse Action Plan will continuously update the tool with regulatory and technical information about new end-uses for water reuse. Some newly added reuse applications that will be highlighted in the REUSExplorer tool webinar include end-uses of agricultural, livestock water, and landscape-related applications were recently added to the tool. The tool already includes information on potable water reuse, onsite non-potable water reuse, and other centralized non-potable reuse applications.

Dr. Rabia Chaudhry, a member of EPA's Water Reuse Program, will teach participants how to use the tool, explore different guidelines, and regulations for water reuse across states for a variety of alternative water sources and end-use applications.
