Led by a steering committee that includes the Value of Water Campaign (<http://thevalueofwater.org/>) (VOW), of which AMWA is a member, United for Infrastructure: 2021: A Week to Champion America's Infrastructure (<https://unitedforinfrastructure.org/the-week/>) will take place May 10-14. Organizations across infrastructure sectors, including water, electricity, transportation, and broadband networks, will come together for a coordinated week of virtual events to highlight the important role infrastructure plays in public health, the economy, the job market, and national security.
