# Source Water Collaborative webinar on wildfire impacts to drinking water to include AMWA member

July 19, 2021 at 5:00 AM

The Source Water Collaborative is hosting the fifth webinar in its Forestry Learning Exchange (<https://sourcewatercollaborative.org/connect-with-others/learningexchange/>) series that focuses on the connection between healthy forests and drinking water on July 27 from 1:00 to 2:00 p.m. ET. This webinar is the first of two parts that will discuss wildfires and the risks they pose to drinking water. Partners from the Rio Grande Water Fund (<http://riograndewaterfund.org/>), including AMWA member Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority, will describe the watershed-wide approach the project has taken to reduce wildfire risk across 600,000 acres.
