

SAB deliberates EPA framework for developing regulation on PFOA, PFOS

January 10, 2022 at 5:00 AM

The Science Advisory Board (SAB) last week concluded a series of meetings to review EPA's proposed approaches to the derivation of Maximum Contaminant Level Goals for PFOA and PFOS in drinking water, an analysis of cardiovascular disease risk reduction due to reduced amounts of PFOA/PFOS in drinking water, and a draft framework for estimating noncancer health risks associated with mixtures of PFAS. EPA charged SAB with reviewing its draft documents to support the National Primary Drinking Water Rulemaking for PFOA and PFOS.
