



## **Sr. Manager, Regulatory Services** Laurel, Maryland

We are actively seeking a **Sr. Manager, Regulatory Services** to lead and manage the activities of the Regulatory Services Division. Responsibilities include **WSSC plumbing and gas-fitting regulation enforcement, code development, cross connection control, contractor permitting and licensing, industrial discharge permitting and inspection, and fats, oil and grease (FOG) permitting and inspection.**

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Supervises plumbing and gas-fitting regulation enforcement processes
- Monitors developments and innovations in the plumbing and gas fitting industry and makes recommendations on technology implementation within WSSC's service area
- Provides engineering leadership and investigates and justifies revisions to WSSC's plumbing and gas fitting policies and procedures to assure public safety, environmental regulatory compliance and cost effectiveness while increasing quality and reliability
- Develops and implements effective policies and procedures to minimize/eliminate cross connections; oversees the prevention of contamination of WSSC's potable water supply from on-property sources
- Supervises plans review (plumbing, fuel gas, site utility), licensing, and the issuance of permits; administers WSSC's Systems Development Charge confirmation policy
- Develops and implements effective policies and procedures to regulate and minimize industrial discharge and hazardous and toxic waste spills
- Supervises the processing of requests for investigation of complaints such as hazardous and toxic waste discharges and initiates and signs warrants and injunctions against persons and corporations who violate industrial waste regulations
- Develops and implements effective policies and procedures for control of fats, oil and grease (FOG)

- Reviews the WSSC Consent Decree and its requirements and revises/updates policies and procedures as appropriate; researches best practices related to elimination and/or control of FOG-related sanitary sewer overflows
- Develops, negotiates and manages contracts with outside engineering consultants, contractors and vendors providing specialized inspection, testing and technical support
- Directs or assures development and implementation of effective individual development plans for each employee; Counsels and taking appropriate action to reward or discipline employees (including termination or recommending termination)

**Qualifications:**

- BS degree in Mechanical, Chemical, Civil, or Environmental Engineering or related discipline
- 10+ years engineering experience in the areas of code enforcement or utility operations and/ or maintenance
- 5+ years supervisory experience
- **3+ years' experience in plumbing and gas fitting, engineering design management, industrial waste operations, FOG regulations, related water/ sewer infrastructure, or code development and regulatory administration**
- **Comprehensive knowledge of engineering principles and practices of plumbing, gas fitting and industrial waste systems or related infrastructure**
- **Comprehensive experience in regulations, code administration and policy development including those of the EPA, other federal, state, and county agencies, and national plumbing code regulations**
- **Must be registered as a Professional Engineer in Maryland or able to obtain reciprocity within 12 months of hire date**
- Possession of a valid driver's license and ability to obtain a WSSC driver's permit
