House, Senate Subcommittees Learn Details of Drinking Water Infrastructure Needs

Congress turned a triple-play on infrastructure last week, holding three hearings in two days on water infrastructure funding needs. The Senate Committee on Environment and Public Works' water subcommittee held the first hearing on March 27. Two hearings in the House followed the next day.

Testifying on behalf of the Water Infrastructure Network (WIN), of which AMWA is a member, Gloucester, Mass. Mayor Bruce Tobey told the Senate subcommittee, "The nation's water infrastructure represents more than a century of investment, substantially funded by local tax payers." Tobey further noted the enormous investments that will have to be made over the next twenty years.

Bill Elmore, senior vice president and COO of the Knoxville Utilities Board, represented AMWA and AWWA before the House Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment. Beverly Ingram, assistant director of the Detroit Water and Sewer Department, testified for AMWA before the Subcommittee on Environment and Hazardous Materials of the Committee on Energy and Commerce. *Excerpt from the March Congressional Report.*
