**\$3.8 TRILLION** ← **\$50B**

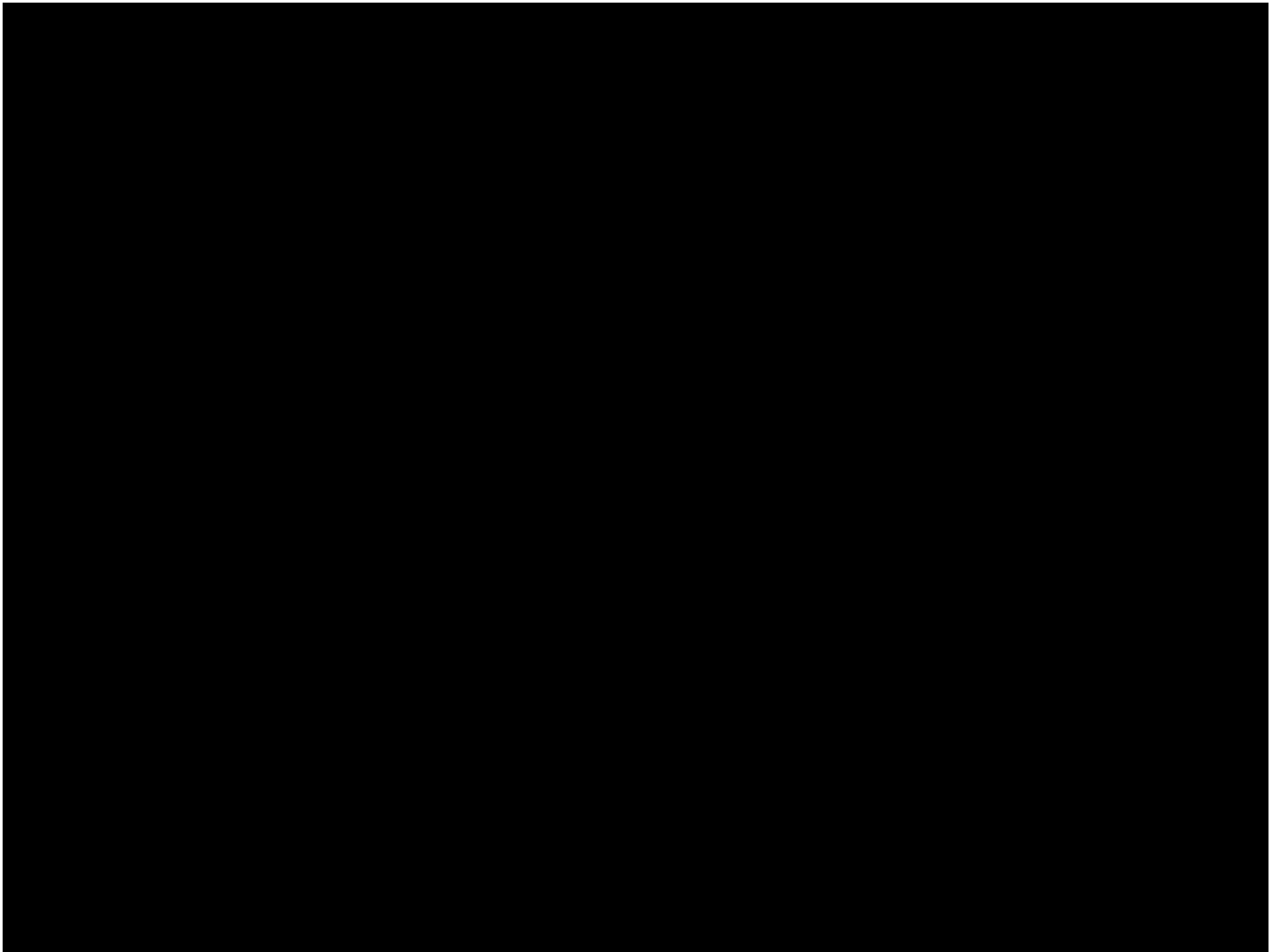

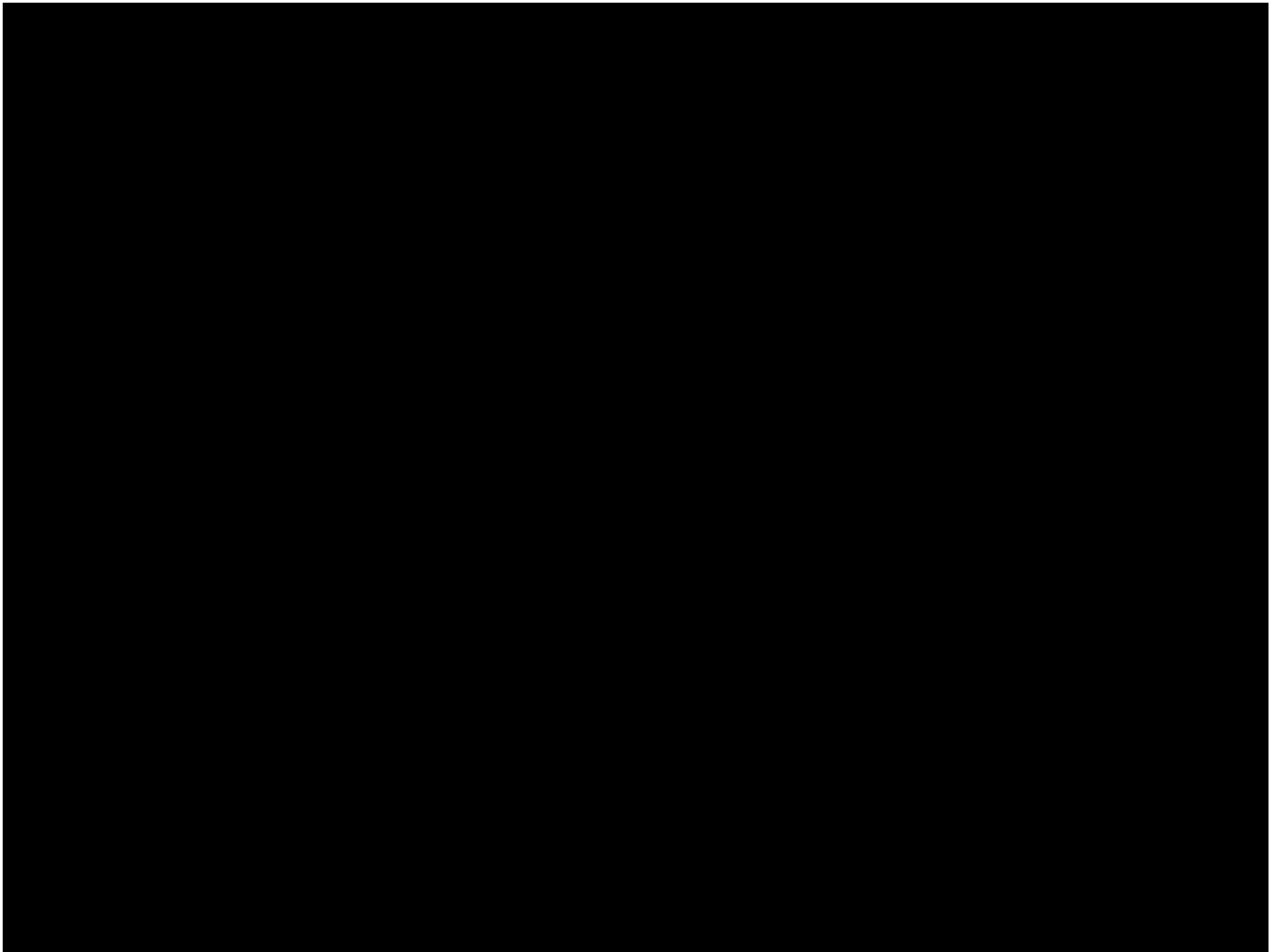
