Preparing Adult Offenders to Transition through Training and Therapy (PAT³)

The City of Atlanta Department of Corrections (DOC), in partnership with the Atlanta Department of Watershed Management (DWM), Atlanta Department of Public Works (DPW) and the Georgia Department of Corrections (GDC) recently launched a new reentry program, Preparing Adult Offenders to Transition through Training and Therapy (PAT³).

- The program focuses on the reentry needs of incarcerated males with children by providing job training and employment opportunities with the City of Atlanta
- PAT3 is designed in a three-tiered process: state mandated vocational training, workforce development and employment
